Ontario Winter Games 2026 will be in Orilla/Ramara from February 20-22, 2026

All players must be born in the years 2008 or later.

All players must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident

Any players selected by Badminton Canada to represent Canada in any "external' multi-national event (e.g. World Junior Championships, Junior Pan-Am Championships etc.) whether or not they actually attend the event are ineligible to participate in the 2026 OWG.

Players must be members of an affiliated club in the Ottawa District Badminton Association or have a permanent address located within the boundaries of the District in which case Government ID must be shown with the address.

A player is not eligible to tryout for Ottawa District if they have played in the closed badminton championship in any other district, province or country that is just prior to the Games.

Players must have a current Badminton Ontario Competition Player Card.

Please note that full eligibility requirements will be updated from Badminton Ontario but these are the requirements that the District predicts will be final. If for some reason you do not meet these requirements but wish to tryout, please contact Silvesta Ng @ ottawa.owg.coach@gmail.com

The team travelling to the Games will be comprised of 5 males + 1 alternate and 5 females + 1 alternate. Selection of the team is based mostly on the results of this tournament at the discretion of the team coach

All team members that travel to the Games will be expected to pay a player's fee of a yet to be determined amount. For information, the amount was \$175 for the previous games. Practice times and team uniforms will be provided for all selected players. For those players travelling to the Games, registration, travel, accommodation and meals will also be provided.

Format of the tournament will be based on number of entries.
