- 3.1 Monday May 13, 2024 or earlier when the entries are full. Late entries will be permitted at the discretion of the tournament director;

- 8.1. The ODBA Junior District Championship 2024 is run under the discretion and direction of the tournament committee. The tournament will be governed by the rules and regulations as outlined in this document.

- 9. Competition Format
- 9.1 The ODBA Junior District Championship 2024 will consist of the 3 categories and 4 age groups listed above. A cap of 16 players will be applied. Each event will be run on a Round Robin format. The organizers reserve the right to drop an event, combine two events, or change the format of an event from Round Robin to AB based on the number of applicants. A player cannot register for same event in two age groups, ie. U15 single and U17 single.

12. Athlete Participation

12.1. Athlete eligibility for the 2023-2024 season is as follows:

12.1.1 U13: born in 2012 or later 12.1.2 U15: born in 2010 or later 12.1.3 U17: born in 2008 or later 12.1.4 U19: born in 2006 or later

For every age group, the year stated is the birth year. For example, if you turn 18 on or after January 1st, 2019, you are eligible to play in the U19 division.

13. Restrictions

13.1 Junior players from all districts and provinces are welcome to participate. ODBA rankings points will be awarded to ODBA affiliated players. Players of all skill level are welcome.

14. Draws, Seeding & Ranking

- 14.1 All seeding will be done by the tournament committee using the results from regional, provincial and national tournaments.
- 14.2 The tournament will use Club separation rules in the draw making process to reduce the number of same club matches occurring in the first round of a draw.
- 15. Coaching Guidelines / Guide pour les entraîneurs
- 15.1. The ODBA Junior Tournament 2024 will follow the coaching instructions as outlined in the ODBA guidelines for ODBA ranking tournaments at:

https://www.badmintonottawa.com/N/Jr-Ranking.htm. In such, the tournament will follow normal badminton rules such as allowing coaching between games. If it is a 1 game 21 point, coach should be allowed to coach at 11. Follow BON rule with exception that coach doesn't need to be certified.

16. Uniforms

- 16.1 Generally, coloured clothing permitted. The referee reserves the right to ask competitors to change inappropriate clothing. Shorts that extend below the knee are deemed inappropriate clothing.
