

West Carleton Adult Recreational Badminton Club – Quick Facts

The West Carleton Adult Badminton Club meets for recreational badminton every Wednesday evening at Stonecrest Elementary School, 3791 Stonecrest Road, Kinburn. There are six badminton courts available.

The club accepts a limited number of junior members 15 years of age and up as of September 1, of the current year, who are children of an adult member of the club and are accompanied at all times by a parent member.

Badminton begins on Wednesday in mid-September (-first date allowed by the schoolboard-) at 6:30 p.m. Registration forms are available on the Web site and can be sent with the fees to the address shown on the form (before the season begins) or printed out and brought to the club any Wednesday evening.

The hours are 6:30 to 10:00 p.m. every Wednesday from mid-September the end of May with the exception of the holidays for Christmas, New Years and March Break.

Membership is limited to 80 members. If membership reaches this limit, the club will establish a waiting list for new members.

The cost of membership is on the Adult / Guest registration form. (Juniors pay the same rates.) Guest fees will be credited against membership fees for those who subsequently become club members.

This is a recreational club. Players of all skill levels are welcome. Matches are organized on an informal basis. We encourage all members to rotate between games so that everyone gets to play with a variety of different players each night.
